

Personal, Social & Emotional Development:

We will settle all the new children into class encouraging them to form friendships and build relationships with staff within the room.

The children will be encouraged to learn that some things are shared and show understanding of boundaries with adult support.

Physical Development:

Settling the new children into class, we will encourage them to drink from a cup without spilling and begin to feed themselves competently at the table at mealtimes.

The older children will be encouraged to show awareness of the toilet and what it is used for, clearly communicating wet/soiled nappies.

Using a variety of fine motor and gross motor equipment the children will be encouraged to become more physically active with activities linked to our current themes.

Communication & Language:

The children will be encouraged to begin to ask simple questions and express themselves using single words and short sentences. We will use a variety of activities to encourage speech and language and show our understanding of the classroom routines.

The older children will be encouraged to learn new words rapidly and be able to use them in communicating throughout the day.

Literacy:

We will look at a variety of books linked to our current themes and encourage the children to explore the literacy area, showing interest in books and rhymes.

We will start to look at and distinguish different marks made using a variety of tools and equipment
