## Prime areas

### Personal, Social & Emotional Development:

- How do we keep warm in the winter?
- Help our friends with their coats and winter clothes, hats, scarfs and gloves

### Physical Development:

- Encouraging self-help skills get the children to put on their own winter clothes for outdoor play such as, hat scarf and coat.
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### Communication & Language:

- Encouraging the children to ask a variety questions and using simple sentences to talk about winter and things in the environment.
- encourage the class to have a strong exploratory impulse and talk about what they can see outdoors

## Specific areas

### Literacy:

- read and discuss the snowman book
- repeat words and phrases from familiar stories and rhymes such as frosty the snowman and ten little penguins.
- Jack Frost book

### Understanding the World:

- Freeze objects into ice and discuss it melting
- Place ice in the tuff tray is it warm or cold?
- What colours are penguins and polar bears?
- Snow play in tough tray

### Expressive Arts & Design:

- Create snow pictures on black paper
- Ten little penguin's song
- Make snow people using cotton wool
- make a penguin collage
- Winter scene pictures
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### Mathematics:

- Winter matching games
- Count the snowballs in the box
- Size ordering snowman (big/little)
