



Literacy:

- This half term we will be looking at writing our own non-fiction explanation texts and instructions, through the reading of fiction and non-fiction texts. We will learn how to use all the skills we have previously learnt and use these in our writing pieces.



Numeracy:

-This half term we are going to be looking at using a variety of different maths skills to further the understanding of measure- looking at measuring length/ height, mass and capacity and time! We are also going to consolidate our understanding of division and multiplication also



Science:

This half term we are going to be learning about living things and their habitats. The children will explore different types of habitats first hand and they will carry out investigations to find out about living things and their habitats.
