(A non returned or non signed agreement will also be interpreted as consent for our policy and proposals).

- maintain excellent lines of communication with parents.
- contact home if there is a problem with attendance or punctuality.
- inform the parents of any concerns that might influence their child's work, attitude or behaviour
- prepare monitor and assess homework and other opportunities for home learning on a regular basis.
- appreciate and support the crucial role of single parents in their commitment to their children
- give parents appropriate notice of time-scales and deadlines.
- arrange suitable parent evenings, during which time children's' progress can be discussed.
- prepare detailed annual reports for parents and governors
- keep parents well up to date with school activities through regular notes, notices, news sheets and newsletters for home.
- support all policies and guidelines and make them readily available for parent's scrutiny.
- support the school 'ethos' and 'mission statement', reviewed annually.
- support the aims of the school.
- provide learning opportunities for all our children.
- appreciate individual need within a collective context.
- provide a broad, well balanced, detailed curriculum combining provision for need and opportunity.
- be open and welcoming at all times.
- to support all children in their spiritual, moral, social and cultural development irrespective of their colour, creed, gender or ethnicity.

- ensure that we are smart and appropriately dressed at all times.
